BOSS is an independent organisation that campaigns to reduce crime on Britain's service stations, working in partnership with the police.

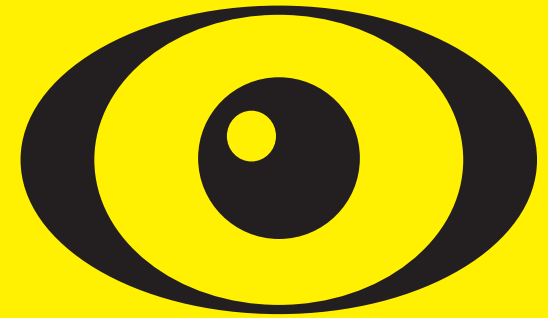

> BOSS No Means of Payment Recovery scheme

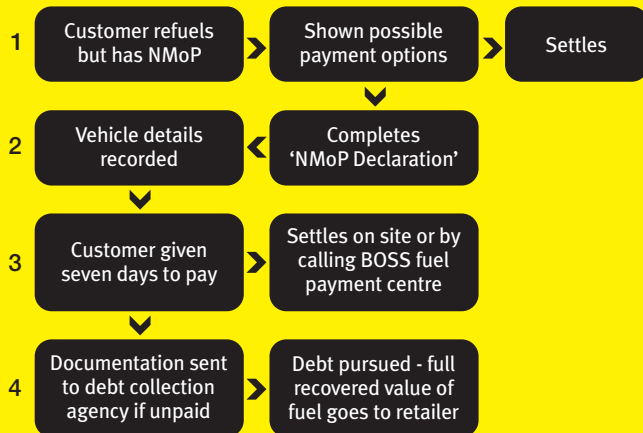
BOSS has launched a pioneering No Means of Payment Recovery scheme, which puts in place a co-ordinated system for recovering financial losses incurred by incidents where drivers fill up, claim to have 'No Means of Payment' (NMoP) and subsequently fail to return to pay.

Pilot schemes in Hertfordshire and Nottinghamshire have achieved more than 80 per cent NMoP recovery and significantly reduced crime at participating service stations. The NMoP scheme is designed to provide an easy means of settlement for motorists who find themselves in the embarrassing position of having no immediate means to pay for fuel they have taken. However, thanks to BOSS's partnership with specialist recovery agencies, criminals who deliberately fill up with no intention of paying will be pursued on behalf of retailers.

The NMoP Recovery scheme costs **£99 + VAT per site** to BOSS members. Each pack contains a complete set of documentation for managing a NMoP scheme.
